


## Citing a newspaper article on a database - MLA Cite it at easybib.com

**Database definition:** A structured, electronic collection that may contain full-text articles, abstracts, data, and citations – typically requires subscription access

Structure: Citation of original source. Database. Web. Date accessed. < URL>.

\*Note: First cite the source found in the database, and then add database information. Also, the URL is optional. Consult your teacher

**Database:** ProQuest Newspapers



**Newspaper structure:** Last, First M. "Article Name." *Newspaper* Day Month Year, Edition, Section: Page(s). Print.




## Citing content published by a database - MLA Cite it at easybib.com

\*Note: This is for a database article published directly online by the database with no in print original

**Structure**: Last, First M. "Article." *Database / Source.* Database publisher, Date created or updated. Web. Date accessed. <URL>.

\*Note: URL is optional. Consult your teacher



**Article Footer –** Often contains database and publisher information

Source: Contemporary Authors Online, Gale, 2010.

Contemporary Authors Online

Gale Database: Contemporary Authors Online

The footer shows that the source was published originally by the database. You can look for the citation of the article to give you an idea if the source was originally published elsewhere and then hosted by the database, or published by the database itself

Data accessed: Depends on the day

Database publisher: Gale

Structure: Citation of original source. Database. Web. Date accessed. <URL>.

## Article Footer - Shows original publication information of article



Encyclopedia Year Published Publisher

City published: Boston

Found in citation at the bottom of the page

**Data accessed:** Depends on the day

**Encyclopedia structure:** Last, First M. "Article." *Encyclopedia*. Edition.

City published: Publisher, Year published. Print.

\*Note: Well known encyclopedias only require year and edition as publication information
